SUNDAY OF THE MYRRH-BEARERS

After the entombment of Jesus and the Sabbath day of rest, the three women went in secret to the place where the body of the Crucified had been laid. They went in haste with the same faithfulness with which they had followed Jesus on the roads of Galilee and Judea, and straight to Golgotha. They brought with them oils with which to anoint and embrace his lifeless corpse one last time before he would return to dust. But the tomb is empty; only the winding sheets remain (Lk 24:12), and they find life ahead. The dawn they had awaited before returning to the tomb heralds the most important day in the history of mankind: the Resurrection. They do not know it yet, but they are to be the first heralds, the living witnesses of a truth that we live and comprehend through our faith. The two men in dazzling apparel bring new hope to their broken hearts. Here they are before the triumph over death and suffering. Life, born from the shadows of the tomb, has had the final word.

Resurrection People

Don't let this feast go by without reflecting on our advantages as resurrection people. Accept Jesus as a living Lord and welcome his life as your own. Embrace life in its fullness – with bad parts and good as all part of God's loving plan. Rejoice today in Christ's victory over suffering and death; trust that you share that victory. No matter what hardships you face, you will prevail. Refuse, therefore, to be dominated by any negative and defeatist thinking. Rise from the dead. Your redeemer lives and invited you to do likewise.

GOD'S PROMISES

If you indeed call God your Father, then trust in Him as in the one Father, most merciful, all-powerful, most wise, ever-loving, ever perfect. Trust in Him in respect of the blessings of this temporal life, but above all, in respect of the future blessings which shall be granted you in Christ Jesus. But as through the love of the heavenly Father for you, you have become a child of God. For you have come forth from Him endowed with reason and free will; so on your part you should make every effort to reach that blessed and eternal heavenly inheritance as promised by Him.
