## JESUS – OUR ROCK OF AGES

You can never expect to keep an eagle in the forest. You might be able to gather a group of the most beautiful birds around him, provide a perch for him on the tallest pine, or enlist other birds to bring him the choicest of delicacies, but he will reject them all. He will spread his proud wings and, with his eye on an Alpine cliff, soar away to his own ancestral halls of rock, where storms and waterfalls make their natural music.

Our soul longs to soar as an eagle and will find rest with nothing short of the Rock of Ages. Its ancestral halls are the halls of heaven, made with the rock of the attributes of God. The span of its majestic flight is eternity "Lord, YOU have been our dwelling place throughout all generations" (Psalm 90:1).

#### NATIVITY FAST: November 15 – December 24

On November 15<sup>th</sup> the traditional 40 day fast preceding Christmas begins in the Byzantine Rite. This fast is known as the Nativity Fast or Philip's Fast because it starts the day after the Feast of St. Philip (November 14). This period was set aside by the Byzantine Church as a period preparing for the Feast of the nativity of Jesus Christ. A highly developed liturgical structure never evolved for Philip's Fast, nor was the fast ever as strict. In fact, little mention is made at all about preparing for Christ's nativity until two Sundays before Christmas with the Sunday of the Forefathers. With the secular preparations for this feast beginning sooner and sooner every year, it is only fitting that we observe this traditional fast as a way to keep a proper perspective for Christmas. Christ will not be brought back into Christmas with clever slogans, but only with spiritual preparation through prayer and fasting.

### MERCY CENTER FOR WOMEN CHRISTMAS COLLECTION

The Mercy Center for Women serves women & children who may be homeless or need emotional, financial, spiritual, rehabilitative, or life-skills assistance. They house women and children at their facility while women are going through the various programs to get on their feet. This collection will help their Christmas celebration.
