PASCHAL TROPARION: Christ is risen from the dead! By death he trampled death; and to those in the tombs he granted life.

ALL WE LIKE SHEEP

Sheep are lovely animals to behold, but they really are not all that intelligent. If it were not for the shepherd, the sheep would constantly run the risk of wandering off and/or getting eaten by predators.

Various scripture verses involve sheep. In 1 Samuel, David, the shepherd boy is called to lead the nation of Israel, and is anointed its king, even though he is just a lad. God sees differently than we humans do, and what is pleasing to us may not be pleasing to God, and vice versa.

The 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm is probably the most popular out of all 150 Psalms. Even those folks who know none other usually know a little piece of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm. Its words speak loudly and clearly to those who read, recite, or sing one of the many various renditions of it. It gives us peace, knowing that we are being protected by the almighty shepherd.

Jesus brings this home when He says, “I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep, and mine know me” (John 10:14). Even though we stray like sheep – sometimes repeatedly – Jesus calls us back to Himself – repeatedly! As the Loving Shepherd, He will protect us from the wolf who tries repeatedly to come and snatch us up.

Mary, Our Mother

Mary is a mother who knows our pain. Maybe that is why Jesus, on the cross, shared her in a special way when he said to the beloved disciple – and by extension to all of us – “Behold, your mother” (John 19:27). Mary’s role in the Church and in our lives is focused on keeping us close to Jesus. She is always right there with him, drawing people closer to his heart. For those who are concerned about Mary’s role, St. Maximilian Kolbe said, “Never be afraid of loving the Blessed Virgin too much. You can never love her more than Jesus did.”

Invite Mary into your home, your life, and your heart. She wants to be in solidarity with you in your sufferings and celebrations, sharing tears of sorrow and of joy alike.
